River Loughor and Teifi (Salmon and Sea Trout season): 20 March to 17 October;

River Loughor and Teifi (Brown Trout season): 3 March to 30 September.

Angling for Salmon before 16 June, must be with an artifical fly or articial lure; and any Salmon caught before 16 June must be returned with minimum injury and minimum delay.
